The NSNWA is seeking a Mask Creation Instructor in response to the Covid19 Pandemic and to assist in slowing the spread, the successful candidate must be an experienced seamstress/sewer to conduct online lessons for homemade face masks. The successful candidate must follow the pre-approved pattern guidelines given by the Native Women's Association of Canada. This is a 4-week contract that will require the successful candidate to be responsible to provide a safe and welcoming environment for the women who access programming.

The successful candidate will ideally possess the following qualifications:

- Must have access to quality internet
- Be tech savvy (you will need to use Zoom for online class instructions)
- Ability to speak Mi'kmaq & English in order to assist both speakers
- Must possess their own sewing machine and equipment
- Must be able to follow the pre-approved pattern and execute the product.
